

## Guidelines for Proof-Of-Concept Scheme

1. Any person who is interested in participating in the Proof-of-Concept Scheme ("POC Scheme"), may submit a proposal form stating full details of his project. The proposal form for the POC Scheme is available on the website <http://www.sirent.inlis.gov.sg> under 'Downloads'. Please note that only projects to be implemented in Singapore are eligible for participation in the POC Scheme.
2. A participant in the POC Scheme, may access and use the Real Time Kinematic Service or Differential Global Positioning System Service for free for a period ("trial period") to be agreed between the participant and SLA, only for the purposes of the project stipulated in the proposal form (and not for any commercial purpose whatsoever, whether in Singapore or elsewhere). Only one SiReNT Service may be used for a project at a time, and each SiReNT Service may not be used more than once for a project.
3. All participants in the POC Scheme must, within thirty (30) days after the expiry of the trial period, provide a report to SLA setting out the results which SLA has requested, in a format prescribed by SLA.
4. SLA reserves the right to terminate a participant's participation in the POC Scheme at any time upon giving three (3) days' notice to the participant.
5. A participant may terminate its participation in the POC Scheme only with SLA's prior written consent.
6. SLA reserves the right to publish any information about any participants who have participated in the POC Scheme, and their projects.
7. SLA may, from time to time, amend, vary, or withdraw the POC Scheme, without prior notice.
8. The above are guidelines only and may be amended or varied by SLA at any time, without prior notice, and are not binding on and do not form part of any offer or contract with SLA.
9. SLA may, at its absolute discretion, approve or reject any proposal to participate in the POC Scheme. If a proposal is approved by SLA, the participant shall be required to enter into a formal agreement with SLA, containing such terms and conditions governing his participation in the POC Scheme as may be required by SLA.
